## Strawberries:

**Allstar** – Large to very large; symmetrical; light red fruit with tough, glossy skin. Firm, mild, sweet flesh. Good quality, well suited for freezing. Ripens mid-season. (Good variety for beginners)

**EarligIow** – Medium sized symmetrical, conic fruit. Glossy, deep-red skin with firm uniformly deep red flesh. Exceptional flavor. Fruit good for freezing, dessert and processing. Ripens early. Plants tend to be small with good runner production. Highly recommended by specialist and horticultural agent.

## Blueberries:

**Premier** - Flowers late, so rarely damaged by frost and ripens in June-July, with large berries and excellent quality. It is similar in growth to 'Powderblue' and generally grows 6 to 8 feet tall. Suitable for hedging or shrub borders, with attractive tiny pink or white flowers, and often nice fall colors.

**Climax** – An early producer! Savor loads of large, sweet, early ripening blueberries. Great on cereals or baked into muffins, these southern blueberries are gaining in popularity! These pest-free shrubs reach 6 to 10 feet. Foliage turns fiery red in autumn.

Tifblue - Mid- late bloom

**Powder Blue** - Medium to large size fruit, darker blue in color; sweet taste. Upright highly productive plant; good foliage. Blooms late in season.
